Metro welcomes authorised visitors, tourists, students and rail enthusiasts taking photos of our trains and at our stations. However, some conditions apply:

- Photography and filming of trains is permitted from station platforms and other publicly accessible areas, such as car parks and overpasses at Metro's stations.
- You must not use any form of flash photography or artificial lighting at any time.
- No photography of any sort is permitted in the City Loop, including Parliament, Flagstaff and Melbourne Central stations.
- You must hold a valid ticket to enter any paid area at a station, including all platforms.
- You must respect the wishes of customers who do not want to be photographed and cease taking such photographs on request.
- You are expected to carry some form of identification and produce it on request from a Metro employee.
- All photography and filming is undertaken at your own risk. Metro will not be responsible
 for any loss, damage or injury that you may suffer and will seek to be compensated for
 any loss, damage or injury for which Metro may become liable resulting from your
 photographic or filming activities.

Please note: There are certain rules and conditions all customers and visitors are expected to abide by under the *Transport (Compliance & Miscellaneous) Act 1983*. If you are unsure of any of these conditions, please speak with a Metro employee.
